HIGHWAYS VISIT Tuesday 5th September 2017

The Parish Council has arranged for the Head of Highways at NYCC and other officers to visit Bradley to observe the road safety issues residents have told us they are concerned about.

In addition to James Malcolm and his Highways Officers, we have also invited:

Inspector Geoff Crocker (who will attend the meeting),
Cllr Patrick Mulligan (our NYCC councillor) and
Cllr Andy Brown (our new Craven District councillor).

At 3pm, they will be taken on a short car tour from Bradley to Cononley, to Snaygill roundabout and then back to Bradley village to experience the A629 and the approach routes to our village.

From 3.30 - 3.45pm we will be at the bus stop near **Skipton Road/ Mill Lane junction** to observe the area around the school at the end of the school day.

From 4.00 - 4.10pm we will be at the bus stop at the end of **Ings Lane** to observe the junction with the **A629** and also the experience of pedestrians crossing the A629.

At 4.30pm - residents are invited to the Village Hall to meet with Highways officers, share your experiences and concerns and ask any questions.
