The line proposed from the stone gate post at the Mathew Lane entrance to a point 2.8 metres from the rear corner of the toilet block is a reasonable solution and probably in our favour.

### 010.20 To receive an update on the resurfacing of the Amenities car park.

The Canal & River Trust are looking at a potential restart date of 1<sup>st</sup> July, subject to change, there is about four weeks work left to do.

Cllr Barron has spoken to the engineer who suggests putting a water tank under the car park to hold water back in heavy rainfall, this would satisfy the planners criteria. There are a lot of service pipeworks under the car park. It was questioned if the hardcore would be able to withstand being driven on if the tarmac laying was delayed? Item deferred to next meeting.

Cricket Club grass cutting.

The Cricket Club have provided a risk assessment and work statement for cutting the playing field grass and therefore have been given permission to resume grass cutting.
