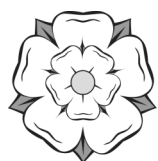

Imminent Submission of

Bradley's Neighbourhood Plan

In accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012, Bradley's Neighbourhood Plan is about to be submitted to Craven District Council.

The plan sets out policies to guide future use and development of land within the Parish and has been prepared in accordance with the statutory requirements and processes set out in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended by the Localism Act 2011).

Once submitted to Craven District Council, the Plan will go to an independent examiner approved by Craven and the Parish Council, then, following any final amendments suggested by the examiner have been made, a referendum will be conducted by Craven District Council across the Parish where residents on the electoral register will vote on whether the Plan should be adopted.

Details of the referendum will be widely advertised in due course. A simple majority of voters in favour at the referendum will be required to ensure adoption of the Plan.

There has been in depth consultation over the many years it has taken to bring the Plan to fruition and, once adopted, it will make for better planning decisions across the Parish.

Volunteers for Footpath Scheme

North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) have a duty to 'assert and protect the rights of the public' to use public highways, by keeping them capable of use and free from obstruction. The Countryside Access Service (CAS) is responsible for looking after just over 6,000 km (3,780 miles) of rights of way in North Yorkshire, outside of the National Parks. The Parish Council has joined NYCC in their Countryside Access Scheme and would like to hear from any volunteers who can assist in keeping the footpaths around the village clear and easy to access.
