Thursday 2nd June 11:00	<p>What: Jubilee Oak Tree Planting</p> <p>Where: Bradley village cemetery, lower field, off Jacksons Lane.</p> <p>Outline: Planting of an oak tree and commemorative plaque. The ceremony will mark the start of the Jubilee celebrations and all residents are invited. It will also be filmed and later uploaded to social media and streamed as part of the Village Hall's exhibition (see below). Vintage news clips and footage from the Queen's Coronation will be shown on the hall's big screen and music from the period will be played.
